Library Rules

1. The Library is open to all Fellows, Members and Associates of the Association who may borrow any book, subject to rules 3 and 7 below.
2. Certain members of the public, journalists and television script-writers whose interest in Radionics is genuine and who are likely to further the Association's interests by their activities, are also permitted to make reasonable use of the Library's facilities, but they are not permitted to borrow books.
3. The maximum number of books allowed to each borrower is three. Books may be inspected, borrowed and returned personally, by previous arrangement with the Librarian, or by post, giving a second choice where possible. A deposit of £5.00 per book is required.
4. Borrowers are required to pay postage and packing at cost on all books sent to them.
5. Borrowers may retain a book for a period of one month. Renewal application should be made to the Librarian before the end of this period if it is desired to borrow the book for more than one month. If no renewal application is made, no reminder will be sent, but a charge of £1.00 will be made for the return notice, together with a fine of £1.00 per book per week. No book may be retained for longer than four months, when it must be returned and may not be requisitioned by the same borrower again until after an interval of two months.
6. Any book may be called in at any time, with seven days notice, from the Librarian.
7. Certain items on the Library list are designated for reference only. These items are prefixed with an R before the title. A volume in this category may only be borrowed from the Library by special arrangement, and by lodging a returnable deposit of £15.00. When borrowed by post, the use of registered post is required, and the cost of this will be charged to the borrower.
8. Certain items on the Library list are available as pamphlets, papers or booklets; and these are prefixed with a P before the title.
9. Borrowers are held responsible for any delay, loss or damage to books in transit to the Library and will be charged for any loss or damage accordingly.
10. Borrowers are requested not to mark any books, whether by writing, turning down leaves or otherwise.
11. Donations to the Library, or books on all relevant subjects are always welcome.
